Jack Jablonski (16) was paralyzed when he was playing hockey on December 30th. He was going after the puck when two Wayzata players came from behind him. The first hit him between the shoulder blades and the second pushed him into the boards. He was lying motionless on the ice and his father knew immediately something was wrong. He was rushed to Hennepin County Medical Center in Minneapolis. The doctors first thought he had a bruised spinal cord and broke two vertebrae, but on Monday they said his spinal cord was severed. Wild players Cal Clutterbuck, Dany Heatley and Devin Setoguchi visited Jack at Hennepin County Medical Center on Monday. Clutterbuck promised Jack he'd score a goal for him. The next day Clutterbuck hit a shot past San Jose Sharks goalie Antti Niemi 7:04 into the first period to give the Wild a 1-0 lead in a game they eventually won 5-4. After the game Clutterbuck said "I told him I was going to score him a goal today, so I thought I'd get that out of the way in the first minutes so I wouldn't have to worry about it all night. I should have scored two or three for him." And on January 7, Jack moved his right arm away from his body, and he was able to flex his left arm. 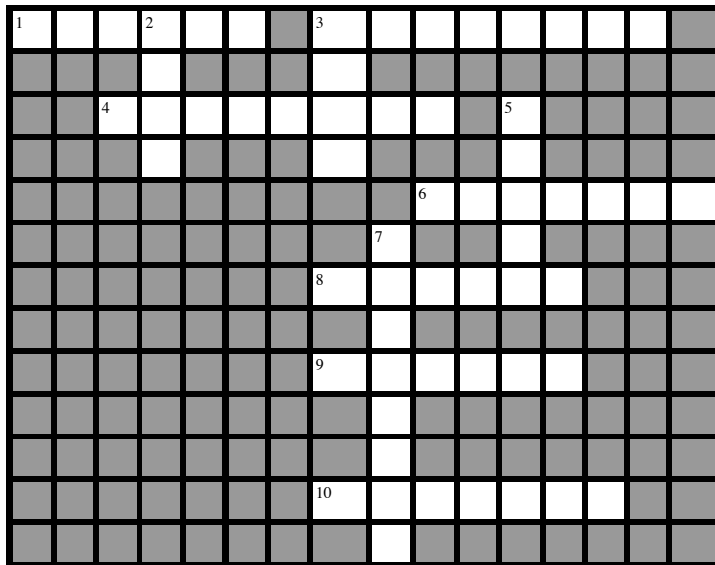

The Son of Neptune Review

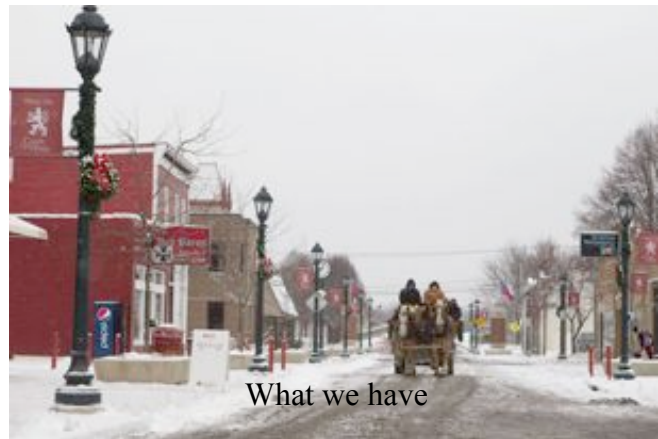
