

Tasks for Bride and Groom

Items to Bring to Rehearsal:

- Bring marriage license
- Bring 2 wedding programs (one for coordinator, one for the Priest)
- Bring unity candle, candle holders and tapers (suggest slow burning)
- Bring fees for musicians, bridal coordinator (\$150), and church donation (customarily between \$50-\$250).
- If you use an Aisle Runner:
 - 124" to entry (112' within church)
 - Bring clear 2" packing tape and scissors

Additional Information

- Who will usher people at the end of the ceremony? You or the ushers?
- The church does not have signs to reserve parking in front of church. Church does have orange cones. If you want this reserved for bridal transportation, this will be your responsibility. Usually a duty of the ushers.
- Complete wedding party at rehearsal, including ushers, parents, lectors and others with special roles.
- Musicians can not practice during rehearsal. They need to arrange a time with the music coordinator, Donna Mae Kadriik: 952-758-2707
- Assign someone to remove your decorations/flowers after the wedding. If removing church floral arrangements, please place in the servers' sacristy and put them back as they were.
- Video/Photographer...are they familiar with church?
 - No flash pictures
 - Any video equipment set up near bridal party is to be unmanned from the arrival to the leaving of bridal party.

Reserved Seating

How many pews need to be reserved:

- Parents/Grandparents
- Wedding Party
- Ring Bearer and Flower Girl (who will they seat with...grandparents?)
- Lectors and Gift Bears
- Other (i.e. family members)

Suggested seating:

- Parents and grandparents in the front pew
- Wedding Party in next pew(s)
 - One pew for 4 or less bridesmaids/groomsmen
 - Two pews for 5-8 bridesmaid/groomsmen
